Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th Place in each jump height, in each class. Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. A jump bar and MACH/PAX rosette will be awarded to any handler finishing a MACH/PAX title at these trials. New title ribbons will be awarded to all dogs completing a title.

Agility Notice to Exhibitors

Please submit a photocopy of the entrant's Official AKC Jump Height Card.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the premises.

ELIGIBILITY STATEMENT

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registrable breed that have obtained an ILP or PAL number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of the dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and /or children create unnecessary disturbances, or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made. **No entry fees will be refunded** if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

All dogs must be on leash at all time, except when in the ring or in the designated warm up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel and campgrounds where they are staying while competing at this trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding a class.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors.

Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height.	All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time MUST enter at the NOVICE level in both Pref. Std and Pref. JWW. The following jump heights shall be used in all Preferred classes.	Owners are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division. For dogs measuring...
8"	4"	11" & under at the withers
12"	8"	14" & under at the withers
16"	12"	18" & under at the withers
20"	16"	22" & under at the withers
24" or 26"	20"	Over 22" at the withers

Bitches in season are not eligible to compete.

BITCHES IN SEASON Upon receipt of a written statement from a Veterinarian postmarked before the date of the show, a refund will be made minus a \$10.00 per day processing fee.

Obstacles The mandatory obstacles and jumps shall be used as described in the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Warm-ups A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

Move ups Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title provided that the request is made in writing to the Show Secretary. (E-MAIL IS ACCEPTABLE). Move ups must be received by Monday Nov, 24 at 6:00 p.m. Day to Day Move ups will be accepted over the weekend and must be received by the close of the trial on Saturday for Sunday.

DIRECTIONS

From North coming down I-75 to I-275: Take I-275 to Busch Blvd Exit (State Rd 580 on Map)....take a right onto Busch Blvd (West). Stay on Busch Blvd...turn LEFT onto Linebaugh Ave. Stay on Linebaugh Ave...turn RIGHT onto Henderson Rd then **Follow the ***** from here.**

From Hwy 19 Area: Take State Rd 580 (Tampa Rd) to Race Track Rd. Go LEFT (North) on Race Track Rd to Linebaugh Ave. Turn RIGHT onto Linebaugh...follow that to Henderson Rd. Turn LEFT (North) onto Henderson. **Follow the ***** from here.**

(You can also come down Gunn Hwy from North Pinellas and from Pasco Counties if that is easier than coming down to SR 580....just follow Gunn to Henderson Rd turn RIGHT (South)...then RIGHT onto Mushinski Rd)

From South: Take I-275 through Pinellas County and across the Howard Franklin Bridge. Get off at the Airport Exit and then follow the signs for the Veterans Expressway. Take the Veterans Expressway North to the Waters Ave Exit (.50 cent toll). At Waters Ave turn LEFT and go to HENDERSON RD (Hess Gas Station on Corner). Turn RIGHT onto Henderson and go under the Expressway and through the light at Linebaugh Ave. **Follow the ***** from here.**

If coming from Homestead Studio Suites come out of the hotel to Hillsborough Ave. Take LEFT and go under the overpass and take NORTHBOUND Veterans Expressway. Take the Veterans Expressway North to the Waters Ave Exit (.50 cent toll). At Waters Ave turn LEFT and go to HENDERSON RD (Hess Gas Station on Corner). Turn RIGHT onto Henderson and go under the Expressway and through the light at Linebaugh Ave. **Follow the ***** from here.**

***** Just past the Emmanuel Achievement Center you will take a LEFT onto Mushinski Rd. Go over the 2 speed bumps....Bonjon Shepherd Ranch will on the right....look for the signs.
