Guidelines for taking useable Photos

1. Get or bring someone to help you and wait a short period of time to get the dog calmed down.
2. All pictures should be taken with the dog standing and at the DOGS EYE LEVEL
3. A straight on head shot
4. A side view head shot
5. A straight on frontal shot
6. A side shot showing the complete dog
7. Report should include approximate height and weight. In your opinion, is the dog over/under weight. What is the length, color and texture of coat What are the dogs markings?
8. Forward photos to the National and Regional Coordinators.
