Proposal #1: Policy-Discipline

Description/Justification: An NSDTRC (USA) discipline policy, created by the above committee, as directed by the June 23, 2022 Board motion. Action: Approval of the policy and replacement of the 10/2007 policy, and its addition to the Board Policy Handbook.

(ATTACHMENT B – To be included in the Board Policy Handbook)

Policy Statement – Discipline

This policy is to ensure the respectful, orderly, and uniform handling of alleged violations of conduct by an NSDTRC (USA) member prejudicial to the best interests of the Club or breed. If

the charges are such that reasonable proof cannot be established, or the alleged violation is not of sufficient degree to require disciplinary action, an educational letter may be sent to the parties involved.

1. **Committee composition and Purpose:** At the beginning of each fiscal year, a Member Investigative Committee will be chosen to serve for the year. This committee will be made up of 3 members and 1 alternate, all of whom are in good standing, and have sufficient experience in the Club and breed. To ensure unbiased investigation, great care should be exercised in choosing committee members who are impartial and neutral. No members may also hold a position as an officer or board member of this Club. The members of this committee shall be from different regions of the Club in rotation. The first committee shall be from Regions 1,2,3,4. The following committee from Regions 5,6,7,1, continuing in rotation in successive years. No member may serve two terms in succession. This committee shall accept, review, investigate, and process the information, and report recommendations regarding the alleged violations. The alternate member shall be available for situations where one of the members feels they may not unbiasedly examine, investigate and make a decision about a complaint presented to this committee.
2. **Reporting:** All alleged violations/complaints of member conduct shall first be sent to the Investigative Committee for review and investigation, and the Committee will report their recommendations before the Board of Directors will entertain the complaint under the By-laws. The recommendation from this committee will stand as written and be adhered to by the Board of Directors.
3. **Notice to the Accused:** Upon receiving written information from the Secretary regarding an alleged violation, the Investigative Committee shall have 30 days to send notice to the accused, speak to the complainant and the accused, evaluate the allegations, and complete a full and thorough follow-up investigation. If the accused has an email address on file with the NSDTRC(USA) Member Chair, notice may be sent by e-mail, and shall be considered received upon confirmation of receipt. Otherwise, the notice shall be sent by regular US mail to the address on file with the membership chair and shall be considered received 10 days after it is mailed.
4. **Remediation:** If the violation appears to be one where remediation is possible, the Investigative Committee shall inform the accused that they have 30 days from the date of notice to come into compliance. The accused shall also be advised that mentoring can be arranged to provide assistance on coming into compliance. The committee shall work with both parties to resolve issues that are determined to not be worthy of referring the complaint on to the Board for disciplinary action according to the By-laws.
5. **Referral of Complaints:** If after the expiration of the 30-day period, compliance has not been demonstrated, or if the alleged violation appears to be non-remediable, the Committee shall prepare a report on its investigation and recommendations and refer the matter to the NSDTRC(USA) Secretary for disciplinary proceedings under the Club By-laws.

Administration: The Board of the NSDTRC(USA) will be responsible for adherence to and implementation of this policy.

Financial: None

Action required: Approve the policy and replace the 10/2007 policy.

Proposal #2: The formation of a committee to investigate the possibility of securing one to three rotating sites throughout the country in which to hold the Toller National Specialty on a rotating basis.

Description: We are proposing that the Board consider creating a National Specialty Committee to investigate the possibility of securing a centrally located site, or up to three set, rotating sites throughout the country in which to hold our National Specialty yearly. The committee would be made up of at least 3 club members. The President would solicit committee members and present the committee to the Board of Directors for approval.

Justification: To ensure that we have an appropriate site each year in which to hold our National Specialty. When the National Specialty moves around each year to new places it forces a new committee to be formed and that committee then needs to secure an appropriate location that can accommodate our club's needs. By not having to secure a new location each year the committee would be able to concentrate their energies on the actual activities instead of spending so much time securing a location that is appropriate and meets the needs of the club and its members.

Administration: After the 1-3 sites are chosen and secured, a committee of volunteers from throughout all regions would be invited to apply each year. The chair would retire after one year and the assistant chair would move up into the chair position. This upward move of the assistant chair would provide continuity from year to year. All other positions would be eligible for anyone to apply to each year.

Financial Implications: None.

Board Action Requested: That this proposal be taken under consideration by the Board. If warranted this could be put to a vote by all club members.

Proposal #3: Proposal to hold the NSDTR Club (USA) in Region 4 in 2024.

Description: The proposal is to hold the National Specialty at All Dog Sports Park / Sycamore Lane Kennels in Lodi, California and the California Retriever Training Association in Suisun

City, CA. from either 12- 19 Oct 2024 or 13-20 Oct 2024. The two dates consider a conflict with Jewish Religious Holidays. Please see **ATTACHMENT D** for complete information on the location, travel to the location, motel and RV accommodations, proposed events, and cost for rental of the facilities. Weather will be moderate and will have cooled down by the middle of October. Some rain may be possible.

- a. Issues to consider when selecting the dates:
 - i. The Field portion of the specialty will be held the first two days and the confirmation portion will be held the last two days. The order of the traditional field competition and the upland test could be changed if the 13 – 20 Oct is selected. People generally like to do the upland test after the traditional field tests.
 - ii. There is traditionally a dinner with the confirmation judge after the last day of competition. If 13 -20 Oct is selected this would be on Sunday night. We may have to consider another dinner to hand out awards on another day during the week. Attendance at a Sunday night dinner may be limited.
- b. Cost can vary dependent of the number of days Dock Diving is Offered. The basic proposal for cost is included in **ATTACHMENT D**. A down payment will be required and is still being negotiated.
- c. Seminars will be offered in scientific areas as well skills areas. The expectation is to have seminars on most days.
- d. The BOD meeting will have to be scheduled. Recommend several evening meetings instead of an entire day. If the Specialty starts on Sunday the BOD meeting could also be on Saturday.
- e. Entry Fees and Fees for Seminars will be designed to cover the cost of the event. A deposit will be required to hold the facilities.

Financial Implications: The necessary budget to put on a National Specialty.

Board Action Requested: Approval to proceed with planning, recommend dates and authorization to process a down payment to the facilities.

Proposal #4: To engage URS Agents as the Club designated Alabama Registered Agent.

Description: Our Club, NSDTRC (USA), is incorporated in the state of Alabama. All corporations and LLCs doing business in AL are required by state law to appoint a registered agent in Alabama. The registered agent must reside/have a physical address in Alabama. Alabama registered agents ensure the Secretary of State and State courts have a reliable way of contacting a corporation or LLC.

Justification: Having a registered agent is a state law in Alabama. On a temporary basis we asked one of our members, who resides in AL, to serve as our registered agent. The temporary time period has long expired and we have the need for a more permanent solution.

Administration: Complete the application for engaging URS Agents and file the Change of Registered Agent form with the State of Alabama.

Financial Implications: The cost is \$99/yr for URS Agents and the one-time cost for the Change of Registered Agent is \$100.00.

Board Action Requested: Engage URS Agents as our Club designated Alabama Registered Agent and file the Change of Registered Agent form with the State of Alabama.

Proposal #5: Sponsorship from Toller Club to the Mid Florida Sporting Dog Association

Proposal Description: This is a request to sponsorship from the NSDTRC-USA parent club to assist with 2 supported entries by the new Mid Florida Sporting Dog Association.

Proposal Justification: The Mid-Florida Sporting Dog Association (MFSDA) was newly organized in October 2016 for and by enthusiasts for the advancement and enjoyment of breeds in the Sporting Group. Membership to this club is offered to all sporting group dogs and their owners. The first supported entry was held on July 8, 2022, in Ocala Florida. This was very successful and well attended for the first show with 187 sporting dogs. The MFSDA is approved to hold 2 supported entries on 11/16/22 at the Greater Ocala Dog Show Grounds. In efforts to help to advance of the involvement of Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers' participation in this event and to support this club that provides events for Sporting Dogs, this request is being made for our parent club to sponsor the prizes.
