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2025 KENTUCKIANA CLUSTER OF DOG SHOWS SPECIALTY SHOW BENEFIT PACKAGE

(Effective April 29, 2024)

A specialty club may choose to hold any of the following events at the Kentuckiana Cluster of Dog Shows and receive the benefits listed below – National Specialty Show, Designated Specialty Show, Concurrent Specialty Show or Supported Entry. Please contact Dianne O'Regan, the Specialty Show/Supported Entry Rep., at doregan@stites.com or (502) 930-2671, with any questions or concerns.

INCENTIVES:

- \$3.50 per dog for National specialties held in conjunction with an all-breed show at the Cluster plus Rosettes (BOB, BOS, & BOW 3 Rosettes total). *see note below*
- \$3.50 per dog for National specialties preceding the Cluster at an off-site facility that SUPPORTS the all-breed entry at the Cluster.
- \$3.00 per dog for Designated specialties held in conjunction with an all-breed show at the Cluster plus Rosettes (BOB, BOS, & BOW 3 Rosettes total).
- \$2.50 per dog for specialty clubs that support the entry of their breed at the all-breed show at the Cluster. In order to support an entry, the specialty club must offer a Best of Breed trophy with a minimum value of \$25.00.
- The Cluster will pay \$4.00/dog (but no expenses) to a judge who is chosen by the specialty club to officiate at its National or Designated specialty, and who is **not** on the all-breed panel. NOTE: The judge will be assigned to only the specialty breed, and the Cluster does not guarantee that the judge will be hired for other breeds at any of the all-breed shows.
- A Concurrent Specialty held as part of the all-breed club's show at the Cluster will receive their monies from the Superintendent less agreed upon fees (as per the contract between the Superintendent and the specialty club). All fees/expenses incurred by the specialty show judge will be the responsibility of the specialty club. The specialty club may use a judge from the Cluster's all-breed judging panel upon paying \$5.00/dog to the Cluster. The judge shall subsequently NOT charge the specialty club for any expenses or a flat fee. The specialty club will be responsible for rosettes and any other awards that are offered.

*NOTE: If the specialty club wishes to offer OTHER rosettes, or any other expanded trophies, they will be at the specialty club's expense and will be deducted from the specialty club's incentive monies. Rosettes offered by the Cluster include: BOB, BOS, & BOW – 3 Rosettes total. ALSO, the specialty club MUST let the Cluster know if it wishes wish to order Rosettes from an OUTSIDE vendor – other than MB-F.

ADDITIONAL INCENTIVES:

- Reserved grooming space MUST be requested via the "Reserved Grooming Form" in the Cluster's Premium List. [Please see attached Reserved Grooming Form and prices.]
- Undraped ringside tables for trophies are supplied by the Cluster at no cost to the specialty club.
- The Cluster invites over 60 vendors each year; we can provide your club with a vendor list.
- Professional ring stewards are provided at no cost to the specialty clubs; if your specialty club wishes to have a member of its club steward instead, please advise us 60 days in advance of the Cluster.
- For RV reservations, contact the Kentucky Expo Center at (502) 367-5384.
- For hotel reservations for exhibitors/judges, contact Kyle Robinson (kyle.robinson@onofrio.com); specialty clubs hiring their own judges are responsible for making their own hotel reservations.
- For on-site meeting/banquet room reservations, contact Edie Nixon (edie.nixon@gmail.com).
- For on-site catering, contact Hailey Hall at Levy's Catering (hhall@levyrestaurants.com). Levy's Catering is the official provider of food at the Kentucky Expo Center. No food for **public** consumption is permitted without prior authorization from Levy's.

SPECIALTY CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES

The Kentuckiana Cluster welcomes all specialty clubs to Louisville! We are pleased to have you with us, and we urge your club representative to contact the Specialty/Supported Entry Rep. with any concerns. To that end, we have summarized our policies in one "central" location, and ask that your specialty club follows them:

- * All participating specialty organizations must complete the "Pledge Form" and "Judge Request Form" and return it by the date(s) indicated on each. We urge your club to get these forms to the Cluster Rep. as quickly as possible.
- * Breeds holding a specialty show (national/designated/concurrent) must supply a Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$1 million listed in the specialty club's name to be forwarded to the Cluster Rep. one month before the start of the Cluster. A Certificate of Insurance protects both the specialty club and the Cluster from any lawsuits.
- * Specialty clubs shall list on the "Pledge Form" the option of providing their own Best of Breed trophy OR asking the all-breed club to supply a BOB trophy. If providing its own trophy, the specialty club **must** deliver the trophy by 9 a.m. to the main all-breed trophy table on the **first day** of the Cluster. Failure to do so will result in a penalty to the specialty club. (Note that trophies for ALL four days can be delivered on the first day of the Cluster.)
- * The Cluster supplies BOB, BOW & BOS rosettes to all participating specialty clubs. However, if a specialty club wishes to purchase rosettes from a different vendor OR purchase additional rosettes from MB-F, the Cluster Rep. must be notified so arrangements can be made. The cost of any rosettes over and above what is offered by the Cluster will be taken out of the specialty club's proceeds; if the cost exceeds the incentive monies, the specialty club will be responsible for paying the overage to the Cluster.
- * Specialty clubs can use ringside (undraped) trophy tables at no cost to their club. Please identify how many tables are needed on the "Pledge Form." Note that the trophy tables are only for the day of the specialty club's event. If another specialty club is in the ring on that same day, the ringside tables shall be shared.
- * Specialty clubs who hire their own judges for their event are responsible for hotel and transportation arrangements. If the specialty judge is part of the all-breed show panel, the Cluster will handle these tasks (concurrent specialty shows who hire a judge from the all-breed panel will be charged \$5/dog for the use of said judge).
- * Specialty clubs holding <u>concurrent</u> shows must contact MB-F Dog Shows, the Cluster's superintendent, for the "show package" that includes a contract which **must** be signed in order to participate in the Cluster. Concurrent specialties will have their own Premium List and Catalog.
- * Specialty club exhibitors are entitled to Reserved Grooming at the Cluster for a **nominal fee**. Reserved Grooming forms **must** be completed, filled out, and sent in to the contact on the form (with payment) by the deadline. The Cluster will do its best to put specialty exhibitors near each other and near their breed ring. Failure to submit completed forms will have specialty exhibitors assigned to the open, non-reserved grooming area.
- * Specialty clubs holding events (nationals/designated/concurrent/supported entry with Sweeps) must submit their paperwork to the American Kennel Club no later than 18 weeks before the closing date (per AKC rules). Copies of this paperwork should also be sent to the Cluster Rep.
- * The Cluster's Premium List and Catalog is massive. Due to its size and content, specialty clubs must adhere to the Cluster's deadlines. Those clubs holding shows shall submit to the Cluster Rep. no later than October 1, 2024 the following information: Club logo, list of Officers/Show Committee members (with an address & contact for the Show Chairperson), trophy list (including ANY challenge or special trophies), and information regarding Sweepstakes' monetary breakdowns (if offered). Clubs holding supported entries must adhere to the deadline date as well.
- * AKC requires all specialty clubs holding events (nationals/designated/concurrent) to have the club's Show Chairman present on the day(s) of the events. The specialty club must have a minimum of three Show Committee members present in case of a Bench/Disciplinary Committee hearing.
